



Jazz vocalist Kelley Sутtenfield performs in Framingham Friday

FRAMINGHAM — Riding the buzz her hot 2009 album, jazz vocalist Kelley Sутtenfield will perform Friday, Oct. 29 at 8 p.m. at Amazing Things Arts Center in Framingham.

A regular in the Greenwich Village jazz scene, last year she released "Where is Love?" to strong reviews from critics who praised her vocal range and diverse repertoire.

Sутtenfield just learned her album on Rhombus Records has been accepted for Grammy consideration in Best Vocal Jazz Album category. That designation means she has been voted to a list by enough members of the National Academy of Recording Arts and Sciences to be considered for the five final nominees for the coveted Grammy.

Embracing contradictions, Sутtenfield has been described as a New York-based singer with Southern roots. She transcends genres in her new CD by ranging from the Beatles to Brazillian standards.

On stage, Sутtenfield expects to perform an eclectic mix of tunes including "Ode to Billy Joe," "Twilight Time" and the Beatles "I love her." At Amazing Things, she'll be accompanied by two guitarists, a pianist and drummer.

She has performed in clubs and concert venues from New York to Las Vegas and recently performed in the Copenhagen Jazz Festival.

Reviewing her new CD, the music critic for **Jazz Times** wrote: "Her album bottles ecstasy in its most natural form and shares it openly."

Amazing Things Director Michael Moran said tickets are still available. Tickets are \$18 and \$17 for seniors and students. Members tickets are \$15 for members.
